
MASSES AND LITURGIES

The Body of Jesus is taken down from the Cross. Mary, his mother, held him in her caring arms.
Pause then reflect - Faith Council member
Think of how painful this moment was for Mary. She must have recalled holding him in her arms as a baby. We think of all mothers who have lost their children and ask Jesus to comfort them

Fourteenth Station Art Club Jesus is Buried
Art Club child to show this station
Art Club Reader
The Body of Jesus was washed and carefully wrapped in a clean sheet. Then he was buried. A large stone blocked the entrance to his tomb and a soldier was told to stand guard.
Pause then reflect - Faith Council member
What happens now? We adore you, O Christ and we praise you.
