

Year 6 to 7 Secondary School Admission

Year 6 to 7 secondary admission round for September 2025

The new secondary school admission round opened on Thursday, 12 September 2024, for parents of current Year 6 children to apply for a secondary school (Year 7) place for September 2025.

The statutory national closing date for applications is <u>31 October 2024</u>.

Applications can be made online via <u>www.essex.gov.uk/admissions</u>. 99% of parents in Essex applied online last year.

All of the application information is available on the website above.

<u>Secondary School Admissions</u> – If you have a child in school year 6, the deadline for secondary school admissions is 31st October. If you are applying for a Catholic school and your child is a Baptised, practising Catholic then there is a form called the Certificate of Catholic Practice that you will receive from Fr Sabu, to take to the school of your choice, which demonstrates to the school that your child is Catholic. It is essential that this form is completed before 31st October. Fr Sabu will supply these forms as follows:

Tuesday 15th October, St Basil's Church, 3pm-4pm Thursday 17th October, Holy Trinity Church, 3pm-4pm

Please bring your child's Baptism certificate with you.
