Last week we had Ofsted calling, this week we had the Catholic Schools Inspection (CSI). Another two days of inspection by two inspectors, but whereas Ofsted were looking at all subjects, this inspection was solely based on the Catholicity of our school, broken down into Religious Education, Catholic Life and Mission, and Collective Worship. As part of the inspection process the team had conversations with children, book scrutinies, multiple lesson observations, and meetings with the RE leads, staff, Senior Leaders, governors, and parents. Thank you to the parents who completed the parent survey and spoke to inspectors in person. Again, just like during the Ofsted Inspection, the aspect that really shone brightly was our wonderful children. CSI have informed us that the result of the inspection will be published around the half-term break, and each member of the school community will receive a copy. # Year 6 to 7 Secondary School Admission

## Year 6 to 7 secondary admission round for September 2025

The new secondary school admission round opened on Thursday, 12 September 2024, for parents of current Year 6 children to apply for a secondary school (Year 7) place for September 2025.

The statutory national closing date for applications is **31 October 2024**.

Applications can be made online via [www.essex.gov.uk/admissions](http://www.essex.gov.uk/admissions). 99% of parents in Essex applied online last year.

All of the application information is available on the website above.

**Secondary School Admissions** – If you have a child in school year 6, the deadline for secondary school admissions is 31st October. If you are applying for a Catholic school and your child is a Baptised, practising Catholic then there is a form called the Certificate of Catholic Practice that you will receive from Fr Sabu, to take to the school of your choice, which demonstrates to the school that your child is Catholic. **It is essential that this form is completed before 31st October.** Fr Sabu will supply these forms as follows:

**Tuesday 15th October, St Basil's Church, 3pm-4pm**

**Thursday 17th October, Holy Trinity Church, 3pm-4pm**

Please bring your child's Baptism certificate with you.

If your baptised child is in year 3-6 from September 2024, please go to the parish website for further information and to download, complete and return the application form via email to [basildon@brcdt.org](mailto:basildon@brcdt.org).
